Gazebo Park:** This exhibit highlights State Archives records that tell the story of the tow of Narragansett, including the town's founding documents, unique letters, photographs, and maps. It aims to bring together the different types of records that are protected at the State Archives and explore the history of Narragansett to tell part of its dynamic story.
